



## GRADUATE STUDY PROGRAM «IMMUNOLOGY: BASIC PRINCIPLES AND CLINICAL APPLICATIONS»

### PROCLAMATION

The School of Medicine of the University of Athens announces the Master's Program (M.S.) entitled **“Immunology: Basic Principles and Clinical Applications”** for the academic year 2024-2025 which has been certified by the H.A.H.E. (Hellenic Authority for Higher Education) and it has been issued FEK 9081/15-2-2024, no. Sheet 1086.

The M.Sc leads to the awarding of a **Master's Degree (M.Sc.)** in “Immunology: Basic Principles and Clinical Applications” after a course of study lasting three (3) academic semesters.

Holders of the first cycle of studies of the Departments of Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Biology, Chemistry of the country or of equivalent institutions recognized by DOATAP abroad are admitted to the M.Sc for obtaining the Diploma of Postgraduate Studies. Graduates of other HEI departments may be admitted under conditions.

The cost of participating in the Master's Program for each student is **€1,000.00/semester**.

The choice of inclusion in the M.Sc. will be based on the following criteria:

1. Degree or certificate of analytical score for final students.
2. Proven proficiency in the English language.
3. Evaluation of letters of recommendation.
4. Personal interview.
5. Any other information related to the candidates' qualifications as evidenced by the supporting documents submitted.

According to the Official Gazette, the supporting documents that the candidates are asked to submit are the following:

- **Candidate application** (available on the website of the Central Secretariat of the Medical School of the University: <https://school.med.uoa.gr/>)
- **Copy of diploma or certificate of completion of studies.** Students from foreign institutions must provide an official translation of their degree as well as a certificate of correspondence and equivalence from DOATAP, according to no. 34, par. 7 of N 4485/17. Final students who, at the time of application, do not yet have a degree, can provide a certificate from the relevant School that they have successfully completed their degree exams and submit their degree as soon as they receive it.
- **Certificate of analytical score of undergraduate studies**
- **Curriculum vitae**, which will include information on the candidate's studies, research or professional activity, potential scientific work and interests.
- **Level B2 English Language Certificate.**
- **Three letters of recommendation.**
- **Photocopy of two sides of the police ID**
- **Scientific publications** (if any).
- Any other element which, in the opinion of the candidates, would contribute to the SE forming a fuller and more complete view.
